Title of the Practice: Best Library User Awards

Objectives of the Practice: To encourage students to make efficient use of library resources and services.

The Context: Best Library User Awards motivate students to utilize their college library's resources effectively.

The Practice: The "Best Library User Award" started in 2023 to motivate students to use the Library effectively. It is based on the frequency of library visits, books issued, and behavior (70%; 30%), and is presented annually during the Library orientation Programme.

Evidence of Success: The initiative has significantly increased library visits and book borrowings. Students have reported improved academic performance and a habit of regular reading.

Problems Encountered and Resources Required: Ensuring equal access to resources and managing increased demand are challenges. Additional funding for resources and staff is necessary.


Note: The College plans to build a Book Bank for marginalized students. Photocopy services will be provided at minimal costs, and subscriptions to good printed journals will be acquired.



Title of the Practice: Nakshalbari College has implemented a dress code for students starting from the session 2019-2020.

Objectives of the Practice: To act as a mark of identification outside the college in situations that requires immediate action.

The Context: Uniforms provide unique identification for students, helping the College administration identify outsiders or intruders. They promote uniformity and equality among students from different economic and religious backgrounds, negating feelings of judgment based on clothing. Uniforms instill a sense of oneness, equality, pride, and team motivation.

The Practice: The introduction of the College uniform began in the academic session 2019-20, decided unanimously in the Teachers' Council meeting on 13-08-2019 and the Governing Body meeting on 20-09-2019.

Evidence of Success: Since implementing the dress code, students have become more disciplined and focused on their studies, reducing absenteeism and boosting a healthy campus culture.


